

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

Soon after you dock, we request that you register at the Golf Pro Shop in front and to the left of the Clubhouse and make arrangements to have your electrical system tested. The hours of operation are 8 a.m.- 6 p.m. You will be requested to sign the Indian Creek Transient Agreement ("Transient Agreement"). This form can be downloaded online and filled out prior to arrival as well.

Payment is cash, credit* and if you are a reciprocal club member** the terms of the agreement will prevail.
